

Chocolate Marshmallow Cookies [Recipe from Jean Buffardi's mother Louise Ryan]

Heat in double boiler: 2 Tbs. butter, One 6 oz. package of Chocolate Chips, and 1 tsp vanilla

Mix 1 egg and 1 cup powdered sugar. Pour egg mixture and small (colored) marshmallows into chocolate. Divide into 2 bundles on Saran Wrap and form into long rolls. Cover with graham cracker crumbs. Put the Saran-Wrapped rolls in foil and chill overnight. Slice in desired thickness. Happy Hands










Longwood Gardens




