1 Mile Race

Joe Duarte survived the Bermuda Triangle Challenge (3 races in three days) during January 16-18, 2026. His son Alex joined him. A miler on Friday, a 10K (6.2 miles) on Saturday and a full marathon (26.2 miles) on Sunday. This Marathon was the most difficult one ever for Joe due to the hilly course!

10K Race (6.2mi)


Joe was glad to finish it as a 70-year-old fella in 6:08:31 despite the hills. He also did the miler in 9:53 and the 10K (6.2 miles) in 1:14:54. He said “Of course I am sore all over but still able to move and go up and down the stairs as needed.”

The **We, Native Deaf People, Are Still Here!** exhibition is on view in Chapel Hall at Gallaudet University through 2026. Long-standing portraits and busts, along with the **Gallaudet at 150 and Beyond** exhibit, have been relocated to make space for Indigenous Deaf voices. Through stories, artworks, and lived experiences, Indigenous Deaf people now define and lead the space.

By decolonizing and indigenizing Chapel Hall, the exhibition affirms Indigenous Deaf presence and explores reclamation and healing through art, language, and history.

Exhibition elements include:

- A land acknowledgment mural by Nancy Rourke
- An educational lounge featuring books by Indigenous writers and family-centered activities
- Sign language-based and tactile features


